I. Develop new ways to promote Faith and Light



- by highlighting what Faith and Light's community and spiritual life offers in response to each country's contemporary cultural needs,
- by using all available means (technological, creative, and cultural),
- by updating documents and making them accessible (with the exception of the Charter).

2. Encourage the growth of all the members of the movement in shared responsibility at all levels

- by finding and preparing people to assume leadership roles,
- by supporting formation sessions and providing appropriate tools.



3. Draw up a sustainable strategic, economic and financial plan

- Design and implement fundraising strategies at every level.
- Increase the movement's income through contributions from all the provinces.
- Continue the collaboration between the international and provincial treasurers.

4. Implement the code of conduct in all countries

- Adapt it to the laws of each country (ecclesiastical and civil).
- Inform all members about the code and involve them in the prevention and reporting of abuse.
- Ensure that all members of the community are treated well, paying particular attention to the most vulnerable.
