



Activity for the Feast of Light

Skit on the theme: “*The light of Christ in our Lives*”

1. Welcome

- **Coordinator:** welcomes everyone and explains the meaning of the Feast of Light.
- **Invitation to shared prayer:**
“Let us ask that God’s light may illuminate our hearts. Lord Jesus, You are the Light of the world. Come to us, enlighten our hearts, and let us rejoice in Your presence.” – spontaneous prayer.

2. Symbolic Introduction: The Light of Christ

- In silence, the **Coordinator** community candle symbolizing Christ is lit.
- Each participant may light their small candle from the community candle.
- **Short reflection:**
“Just as the flame of one candle brightens the darkness around it, so Christ illuminates our lives. We can be light for others.”

3. Introduction of the Angels

- Selected people dressed as angels (e.g., in white robes, with delicate wings or glowing elements).
- **Role of the angels:**
 - They hand out small cards shaped like a flame or a heart with the words: “*The Light of Christ for you.*”
 - They may move gently around the room to soft, calm instrumental music (harp, keyboard, bells).
- **The coordinator says:**
“Angels remind us of God’s presence and love. They help us notice the light of Christ in everyday life.”

4. Light in the Heart – Reflection

- Participants sit in a circle.
- The coordinator asks simple questions:
 1. “When do I feel joy?”
 2. “When can I be light for others?”
- Anyone who wishes may say one sentence aloud or reflect in silence.

Short prayer in the circle:

“Lord Jesus, make our hearts full of Your light. Help us share it with others. Amen.”

5. Short Skit: Darkness and Light

Props: a dark cloth and flashlights or candles.

- The coordinator shows that the dark cloth symbolizes sadness and fear.
- One person holds the light (flashlight or candle) and moves it over the cloth.
- **The coordinator says:**
“In this way Christ dispels the darkness in our lives.”

Participants' activity:

- Everyone moves their own light (flashlight or candle) over the cloth.
- We repeat the refrain:
“*The light of Christ shines in my heart!*”

6. The Light Within Us – Prayer

- Participants stand in a circle.
- Everyone holds a candle.
- **Simple ritual:** we raise the candle and gently turn around ourselves, repeating the refrain:
“The light of Christ shines in me,
The light of Christ shines in you,
The light of Christ shines in the world!”
- We repeat several times so that everyone can feel the rhythm and the presence of the light.

7. Conclusion – Blessing

- **The coordinator or chaplain gives the blessing:**
“May Christ - our Light - illuminate your lives and brighten your path each day. Go in peace and in the light of God’s love. Amen.”

Activity:

- Everyone places their hands on their heart and quietly says: “I am the light of Christ.”
- We extinguish the candles in silence, accompanied by soft music.
